- **7) P.R.E.S.S.T.** (These are all good ways to spend any rest time.)

  - → Rejoice: To experience joy and gladness in a high degree; exult.
  - → Edify: To instruct and improve the mind in knowledge, faith and holiness.
  - → Share: To share blessings, love, kindness, affection and in others' burdens.
  - → Study: To apply the mind to, to read, examine and understand God's Word.
  - → Think: Thoughts of the heart; searched by God, held captive to Him by man.

- **7) O.P.R.E.S.T.** (Always guard your heart against devilish oppressions.)
  - → Obstinate: Perversely adhering to an opinion or purpose; not yielding to reason.
  - → **Prideful:** Inordinate self-esteem, often manifesting itself in contempt of others.
  - → Reprobate: Not enduring proof or trial; not of standard purity; lost to virtue.
  - → Entertained: Turned aside; drawn off course, or from the intended direction.
  - → **Slothful:** Inactive; sluggish; lazy; indolent; idle.
  - → Thoughtless: Heedless; careless; negligent; gay; dissipated; stupid.

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and **healing all that were oppressed of the devil**; *for God was with him*.
